Our child sponsorship program links our children with families across the world, which generously gives a set amount each month and begins a correspondence with the children who are waiting for your response.

How much does it cost to sponsor a child?

Sponsoring a child with Save the Children costs about \$1 a day! You can become a sponsor for \$39 a month. Your sponsorship is truly an investment in children's lives and futures!

Why become a child sponsor with Save the Children?

What is involved?

As well as exchanging letters with the children, our supporters receive cards and letters every quarter providing them with fun and educational information about India. This means that they are learning as well as helping. We started the program in 2018 and so far it has risen over £3,000. This sum has been invaluable in helping to cover the costs of keeping our home open and our girls in school and healthy. Thanks to recent changes, the Indian government now offers free and subsidized education, but some families still struggle to prioritize school for their children, Our sponsors are helping us to maintain a stable infrastructure from which our girls can learn grow and we hope, realize their potential. We ask for a minimum of £10 or equivalent per month, which goes a long way towards providing one of our girls with the support they will need to reach for the stars.
