THE VULNERABLE FOCUS AREA



Vulnerable Children & Families

Caring for vulnerable children and their “families” with physical, emotional, spiritual and social support.

Various support groups are run:

- Teenage girls and boys
- Teen moms (under 19)
- Parents
- Gogos of Hope

Gender-Based Violence

Supporting victims of gender-based violence through walking a journey to recovery with them. Educating the community on their rights related to GBV. Proactively educating young people on anger management and life skills.



Counselling Centre

Offering free counselling to the community for grief, trauma, GBV, family & marriage. Counselling done in the vernacular as required.

Health & Nutrition

Nutritional support for the community through health check days for all Rays of Hope children, health education sessions (diabetes, high blood pressure, HIV+, etc.), nutrition education, growing and distribution of fresh vegetables.

Early Childhood Development

Operating our Hlayisanani ECD centre in Alex, as well as strengthening the capacity of smaller creches and day cares through workshops and upskilling.

Yarona After-Schools Programme

Teaching Grade 1 – 3 children to speak and read English in preparation for learning in English from Grade 4.



RoseAct Saturday School

Providing Maths and English support to Alex children in Grades 4 – 10, as well as extracurricular activities, holiday clubs and an annual camp.

Work Readiness & Upskilling

Equipping young people to handle life outside of school; providing exposure to careers through speakers, career days, visits to workplaces; work readiness preparation; mentoring; computer skills

Career Development

Assisting with career development through various initiatives:

- **Ignition Tertiary Education Support:** Supporting post-Matrics from career guidance to their first job, through applications, mentoring, workshops, peer-to-peer relationships and some finance.
- **Women’s Empowerment Training:** Skills development to find employment or start a small business.
- **Learnerships in partnership with Sparrow FET**
- **Sewing Centre**
